

The aim of this course is to provide delegates with the knowledge and practical skills needed to manage MEWP operations and operatives on a site. This course includes a theory element, with a test being conducted at the end.

Objectives

By the end of the course, delegates should be able to:



- Demonstrate an understanding of relevant regulations, guidance and standards
- Identify their management and supervisory responsibilities with regards to MEWP operations
- Demonstrate an understanding of hire terms and conditions
- Identify the types of training that a MEWP operator must undergo before they can be authorized to operate equipment
- Identify and select appropriate personnel protective equipment (PPE) for the operator
- Demonstrate an understanding of MEWP personnel fall protection
- Identify the different types of MEWP and explain their capabilities/limitations
- Identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions
- Demonstrate an understanding of the daily inspections carried out by the operator
- Demonstrate an understanding of safe operating methods of MEWPs
- Identify poor MEWP operating practices and the hazards that may be present
- Identify the steps that can be taken to minimize risks related to MEWP operations in the workplace.



Duration

The duration of the course depends on the experience level of the delegates attending. Typically, these are:

- 1 Day - Novice Course
- 1 Day - Refresher Course (*to renew current IPAF certificate*).



Attendee Numbers

A maximum of 10 delegates can attend this course.



Location

This course can take place at our training centre in Bo'ness, West Lothian or at a location of your choice, subject to onsite requirements.



Certification

Upon successful completion of the IPAF tests, delegates will be issued with digital certification via the ePAL app, valid for 5 years.

Printed certificates can also be issued for an additional fee.

Delegates who currently hold a PAL license for operating equipment can apply to have the MEWPs for Managers category add to their PAL card.



Progression

To maintain their certification and registration with IPAF, delegates are required to complete a 1 Day IPAF MEWPs for Managers Refresher Course every 5 years.
